I am hoping that you can answer a question I have regarding the new America Invents Act. I am aware that under the new act there will be a new "Electronic filing Incentive" which will be a \$400 fee for applications not filed electronically. My question is this: I understand that if an application is not filed electronically, a fee of \$400 will take place, however, if a Sequence Listing is required and filed later on during prosecution, will there be a fee for filing the Sequence Listing paper and disc?
