Subject: Questions re: proposed rule regarding documents submitted to the USPTO

Two questions:

1. Will the faxing of requests for foreign filing licenses still be accepted if the proposed rules become final? Or will these requests need to be hand delivered to the USPTO?
2. Currently a request for a Corrected Assignment for a PTO error (where no fee is due) cannot be submitted electronically but are submitted via facsimile. Will these still be accepted via fax or will EPAS be adjusted so that these can be filed electronically?
